RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE BY THE COUNTY OF FURNAS, NEBRASKA OF ITS LIMITED TAX COUNTY BUILDING BONDS, SERIES 2015, IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,050,000) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE COSTS OF THE PROJECT DESCRIBED HEREIN; PRESCRIBING THE FORM AND DETAILS OF SUCH BONDS; IMPOSING A TAX TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SUCH BONDS; DESIGNATING THE BONDS AS QUALIFIED TAX-EXEMPT OBLIGATIONS; ADOPTING CERTAIN POST-ISSUANCE COMPLIANCE PROCEDURES WITH RESPECT TO THE BONDS; AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN ACTIONS AND DOCUMENTS AND PRESCRIBING OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO.
